

- ADEYFIELD
- : Turning left into and down Commons Lane, go through the archway which leads to the front of Knightsbridge Way flats, to share the occupants' fine panoramic view (37)
  - : Having walked the full stretch of the path in front of the flats, go back through the final (fourth) archway into Knightsbridge Way, turning left into and along the alleyway which is between the flats and the Towers Road houses
  - : From the steps, walk across Little Road for a view looking across Queensway (from the rails on the other side of the garages) of the adjacent Highfield neighbourhood (38)
  - : Return to and go along Little Road, which leads into Great Road opposite the lower end of Ellingham Road (39). There turn left into and along Queensway (40) to the right, as far as the remaining stretch of the original Highfield Lane (41)
  - : Walk up the lane (41), turning left along the hard-surface path (42) opposite the latest private housing development - The Grazings - to come back into Queensway
  - : Going right, walk to the Swallowdale roundabout (43) and then along High Street Green past Widmore Wood on the left (44) and the half-hidden tumulus on the right (45)
  - : Further down on the left is the water tower (46) which is adjacent to the one-time High Street Farm (47) which is on the edge of High Street Green Playing Field, beyond which, opposite Branksome Close (48), is a row of old flint cottages (49)
  - : Coming to Adeyfield Road, where High Street Green becomes Leverstock Green Road, note the view looking down that road (50) before turning down Adeyfield Road, to pass in succession on the right, Saracens Head (51), Maylands School grounds (52) and finally Adeyfield Lodge (53) before reaching Adeyfield Gardens opposite Everest Way (9)
  - : Go along the original stretch of this road, at the top of which - by the bend - is a pedestrian walkway running between the old and new housing which leads into Hobletts Road. This comes out opposite the old people's ~~home~~ <sup>house</sup> nearing scheduled completion (54)
  - : Walk to the right along Hobletts Road, passing the rear of Maylands Primary School, to come into and turn left down Ellingham Road (55). Go left at the end of the road into and along Great Road (56) which runs into Adeyfield Road opposite Longlands
  - : Turn right and cross over the road to go by the side of the bus shelter (57) and along the path between the flats and old people's houses in Old House Road (58)
  - : Go through the central archway of the flats (59) which overlook The Queen's Square, to complete a walk designed to take in the most significant points of interest relating to activities, events and personalities of the pre-town borough, and for its coverage of landscape and streetscape attractions retained and created by the planners and builders of the first new town neighbourhood to be completed

- EPILOGUE -

Regrettably, inadequate or inept maintenance, deliberate neglect or indifference, vandalism or other acts of spoliation such as litter, and measures of mutilation like graffiti, have diminished the attractions of many neighbourhood features.
